This week, our Scripture readings reveal to us a key characteristic of *who* Jesus is for us---the Good Shepherd. We focus on the Psalm response for our time together. Remember, a psalm is a holy and special song for God.

For some of us, this might be a very familiar Psalm, but I encourage you to look at it with new eyes and a new heart as we seek to understand our own friendship with Jesus in a deeper way.

READ IT! PSALM 23:1-6



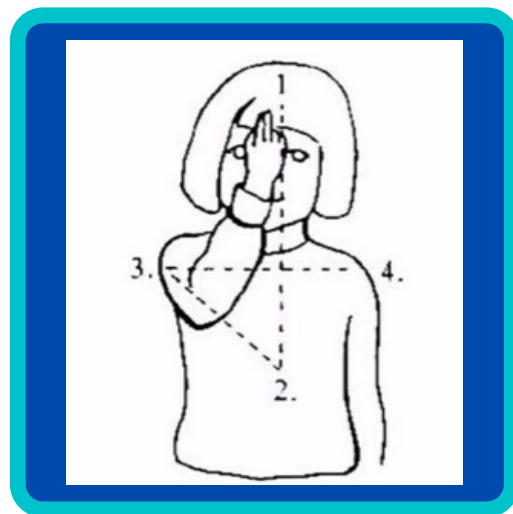
PONDER IT!

1. What does a shepherd do?
2. What needs do you have? How are those needs different from wants?
3. Open your Bible and look up Psalm 23. Write down or underline any of the "actions" that the Shepherd does for his sheep. What does this tell you about the Shepherd?
4. Who do you think the sheep could be?



SPOT IT!

- This week at Mass, look for when we do the Sign of the Cross.
- What do you think you are saying with your body when you make this gesture?
- How many times did you spot this gesture?



LIVE IT!

This week, let's make the Sign of the Cross when we begin and end our prayer times. This might mean when our family prays together when we thank God for our food. Or, it might be when we pray before we go to bed. Make sure to do it when you spot it at Mass!
