# **RESOURCE: CHOOSING A SPONSOR**

#### The Commitment of a Sponsor:

- 1. Assist in the preparation for the Sacrament:
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Attend the Kickoff (April) and Vigil (Nov) half day retreats.
  - Meet with your candidate at least 5 times, leading the discussion with guidebook.
  - Ideally, participate in a service and prayer experience with the candidate. If this is not possible, the candidate can complete on their own.
- 2. Build this relationship. Go out of your way to know, love, and support your candidate. Help the candidate fulfill his baptismal promises faithfully by challenging and encouraging as needed.
- 3. Accompany the candidate and present him/her to the bishop at the Confirmation Mass.
- 4. Continuing to be a source of encouragement and guidance for the candidate after receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation.

## **Qualifications of a Sponsor:**

- 1. Must be a fully initiated Catholic, having received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.
- 2. Sponsors are to be active members of a Catholic Church who attend Mass regularly. Ideally, you would choose someone from one of our three parishes.
- 3. Must be sufficiently mature in his/her commitment to Christ: committed to life as a disciple.
- 4. Must be a minimum age of 16 years. We recommend choosing someone who has been Confirmed for 5+ years.
- 5. The person chosen must have the intention and ability to fulfill this role.
- 6. Cannot be the parent of the Confirmation candidate. Siblings are not recommended, but allowed. Note: if needed, a parent may do the "preparation" piece of the sponsor role, but may not be the official sponsor at the Confirmation Mass.
- 7. Not prohibited by law (canon or civil) from exercising the role of sponsor.

#### Traits to Look for in a Sponsor:

- A sponsor prays, desires to grow in holiness, and live as a disciple of Christ.
- A sponsor participates at Mass each Sunday and serves those in need.
- A sponsor embraces their Catholic faith, and is not embarrassed by it.
- A sponsor serves as a bridge, helping the candidate understand and become familiar with the people, places and traditions of the Catholic faith the candidate is unfamiliar with.
- A sponsor respects the candidate's freedom, allowing the candidate to decide whether this is the right time to seek the Sacrament of Confirmation.

## Tips to Help you Find a Sponsor:

- Pray. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you find the person who will be the best witness and mentor for you. Ask Him to show you who that person is.
- Who is someone you admire and who takes their Catholic faith seriously? (in your family, of your friends' parents, of your parents' friends, your godparents, neighbor, coach, teacher).
- Do you have a friend going through Confirmation with you...could their parent work with you, and your parent work with your friend?
- If both you and a friend struggle to find someone, would you like to meet together with Sarah (or another youth ministry leader), meeting as a group of three?

Prayer for Choosing a Confirmation Sponsor

Holy Spirit, helper and guide, give me wisdom as I choose my Confirmation sponsor. Help me to choose a person of prayer who will teach me also to be a person of prayer, who will support me in difficult times, who will guide me to make good choices, and who will challenge me when I do not. Help me to choose someone who will love me and teach me to love Jesus. Thank you for giving me a community of people around me to support and guide me as I take this important step in becoming more fully a member of your Church. Amen.
